

Instructions for Completing Bachelor's Application Packet

1. Complete pages 1 and 2 of application.
2. Request official transcripts from all schools attended and have them mailed to:

3. Fill out top portion of recommendation letter and give letter and return-envelope to:
 - A. Minister or church leader at your congregation
 - B. Teacher or academic advisor that you have had in the past 3 years who can evaluate your academic abilities
 - C. A close friend (not a relative)
4. Complete a 1-2 page paper stating your reason for wanting to attend Austin Graduate School of Theology, what you will do with your degree once received, and any history about yourself you think may be helpful for the admission committee's review.
5. Applicants must have completed at least 24 hours of general education credits before being admitted into the Bachelor of Arts degree program, including at least 3 hours in English Language and Literature. Applicants that have less than 35 overall college credit hours must submit an official high school transcript and an official report of scores achieved on the ACT or SAT.
6. All admissions documents should be returned by mail (**no e-mailed documents will be accepted**) to the Austin Grad Admissions Office by May 1 for priority consideration for the fall semester, or October 1 for priority consideration for the spring semester.
